This Addendum No. 1 modifies the POAK MAP – Forum Mobility – OEM RFP issued August 14, 2026 (the "RFP") and provides Forum Mobility's responses to questions received from Proposers. Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided under "Addendum Acknowledgement" in Attachment A. Failure to do so may disqualify your proposal.

In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between this Addendum and the RFP or its Attachments, this Addendum controls.

PART 1 – RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED

Question 1. May an OEM dealer submit a proposal in response to the RFP?

Response. No. Consistent with Section 2 (Purpose), only OEMs are eligible to respond to this RFP, and all proposals must be OEM led. A dealer may not submit a proposal independently, and a proposal submitted by a dealer rather than by the OEM will be rejected.

An OEM may use its dealers and other OEM partners in preparing and performing its proposal. Dealers and other OEM partners must be identified in the proposal, together with their applicable roles and responsibilities. Pricing, warranty, service, maintenance, delivery or other terms offered through a dealer may be included in the OEM's proposal package, provided that the OEM is the Proposer, the OEM submits the proposal. Any aspect of the OEM's proposal that relies on individual dealer participation shall be clearly explained. The OEM shall be responsible for the entirety of the proposal, including any dealer-supplied content and any commitment made through a dealer.

Master sales agreement terms (informational only). As part of the proposal package, Proposers are requested to include a copy of the standard master sales agreement, master purchase agreement, dealer sales agreement, or equivalent standard terms and conditions applicable to the sale of the proposed trucks (the "MSA Terms"), including any dealer-form terms that would apply to a purchase placed through a dealer. The MSA Terms are requested for informational purposes only, so that Forum Mobility may review the Proposer's requested commercial terms. Forum Mobility intends to review the MSA Terms against applicable commercial norms and for compliance with the federal grant requirements set forth in 2 CFR Part 200.

For the avoidance of doubt, and notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the RFP: (i) the MSA Terms will not be scored, rated, ranked or otherwise evaluated; (ii) the MSA Terms are not a Minimum Qualification under Section 11 of the RFP and will not be assessed against the Minimum Qualifications; (iii) neither the content of the MSA Terms nor a Proposer's omission of the MSA Terms will be a basis for award, for rejection of a proposal, or for any determination of responsiveness or responsibility; and (iv) Forum Mobility's request for, receipt of, or review of the MSA Terms does not constitute acceptance of, agreement to, or negotiation of any of the MSA Terms. All contract terms remain subject to negotiation and any resulting contract must incorporate the federal terms and conditions required under 2 CFR Part 200.

The MSA Terms should be submitted as a separate, clearly labeled attachment and are excluded from the page limits set forth in Section 12 of the RFP.

PART 2 – AMENDMENTS TO THE RFP

Struck text below reflects the RFP as issued on August 14, 2026. Text shown as amended governs.

1. Section 7.b (Miscellaneous) – conforming amendment.

Original text: ~~Proposers, if other than the manufacturer, shall provide a current, dated and signed authorization from the manufacturer that the Proposer is an authorized distributor, dealer or service~~

~~representative and may sell the manufacturer's products. Failure to comply with this requirement may cause the Proposal to be rejected.~~

Amended to read: Where an OEM Proposer identifies a dealer, distributor or service representative in its proposal, or offers any term through such a party, the Proposer shall provide a current, dated and signed authorization from the OEM confirming that the identified party is an authorized distributor, dealer or service representative and may sell the OEM's products. Failure to comply with this requirement may cause the Proposal to be rejected. Nothing in this Section 7.b permits a party other than an OEM to submit a Proposal.

2. Section 7.d.i (Protest Procedures) – protest deadline.

Original text: ~~Any protest must be submitted in writing to Aaron Nach, Asset Manager, and received by August 19th, 2026 no later than 5:00 p.m., the third (3rd) business day following the date of Proposal opening.~~

Amended to read: Any protest must be submitted in writing to OEMRFP@ForumMobility.com and received no later than 5:00 p.m. Pacific Time on the fifth (5th) business day following the date on which Forum Mobility issues written notice of its intended award to Proposers or transmits written notice that a proposal was not selected.

3. Section 10 (Proposal Submission Details), "Questions and Contact Information" – question deadline.

Original text: ~~Any questions concerning this RFP must be emailed to OEMRFP@ForumMobility.com no later than 5 PM ET on August 19, 2026.~~

Amended to read: Any questions concerning this RFP must be emailed to OEMRFP@ForumMobility.com no later than 5PM Pacific Time on August 26, 2026.

4. Section 10 (Proposal Submission Details) and the RFP Process and Schedule table – proposal deadline and time zone.

Original text: ~~Proposals must be submitted electronically in PDF format to OEMRFP@Forummobility.com no later than 5 PM ET on Friday, September 14, 2026.~~

Amended to read: Proposals must be submitted electronically in PDF format to OEMRFP@Forummobility.com no later than 5PM PT on Monday, September 14, 2026.

The "Submissions Due" milestone in the RFP Process and Schedule table is likewise amended to read: September 14, 2026, 5PM Pacific Time. All references in the RFP and its Attachments to Eastern Time or "ET" are amended to Pacific Time or "PT." Proposals received after the stated date and time may not be considered.

Except as expressly modified by this Addendum No. 1, all terms, conditions, requirements and specifications of the POAK MAP – Forum Mobility – OEM RFP and its Attachments remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Each Proposer is responsible for confirming its receipt of all addenda issued under this RFP prior to submitting a proposal.
